This group show offers the present, if not the future, of nonfigurative painting, and makes it look good enough to eat. Giles Lyon's "Ripple" provides gobstoppers of paint, cut open to reveal treering-like circles of color; and the icing on Dennis Hollingsworth's "Fantastic Voyage" would make Martha Stewart jealous. Standouts in other arton-the-wall media include Jeremy Blake's digital C-print "Guccinam," Bernhard Hildebrandt's darkblue square of enamel on canvas, and Charles Spurrier's fingerprinted, pinwheel-planted "Ignition," in tape, pigment, wood, adhesive, vinyl, plastic, and steel.
